POSITION SUMMARY:

The MDS/RAI/Care Plan Coordinator will work with the RAI Assistant to ensure compliancy with regulations, lead interdisciplinary team meetings and update care plans.

POSITION QUALIFICATIONS:

- Current Idaho Professional Nursing License (RN)
- RAI process trained.
- Previous Minimum Data Set (MDS) experience in long term care facility required
- Computer proficiency in Microsoft Office (Word/Outlook) and keyboarding skill at 30 wpm.
- Operate office equipment, computer, fax, telephone and copier
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills

SCHEDULE:

- Monday through Friday normally, occasional late day if need arises.
- 32-40 hours per week.

ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES/REQUIREMENTS

- Responsible for reviewing clinical records, including medications used, for the last ninety days in preparation for the interdisciplinary meeting. Uses data gathered to complete sections B, C, D, G, H, I, J, L, M, O, P, Q, U and V of MDS form.
- Conducts direct observation/interview with resident.
- Lead interdisciplinary team meeting and record discussion on appropriate report.
- Responsible for communicating information from interdisciplinary meeting to other assigned disciplines.
- Responsible for checking MDS information, V Rap Trigger Summary and Nursing Narrative RAP for completeness.
- Responsible for updating/reviewing care plans by the seventh day after the interdisciplinary meeting.
- Participates in family/resident conference as directed by supervisor.
- MDS/RAI Assistant duties include face/background information and Medicare questionnaire.
- Works with RAI Assistant to review assessment dates for both PPS, private pay and Medicaid residents to meet assessment deadlines and to be compliant as required by regulations.
- Responsible for monitoring QA information (care planning, clinical records) related to MDS. Reviews items identified in QI reports for correctness and supporting documentation for items assigned by DNS.
- Responsible for oversite of accuracy of care plans from physician's orders, restraint reviews, psychotropic review, fall prevention protocol, behavior interventions, pressure ulcer prevention, skin treatments, special car unit, drug administration, monitoring drug responses and any other change in the resident's condition.
- Responsible for identification of residents experiencing significant change, notifies interdisciplinary team members of significant change assessments and time lines.
- Assumes role of charge nurse or med nurse when assigned by DNS.

NON ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES/REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be willing to assist in other areas as the need arises.
- Attend all staff meetings.
- Participates occasionally in resident activities, in-house, as well as out of the facility.
- Stocks supplies.
- Cleans equipment.
- Other duties as assigned.
