A solar eclipse happens when the moon passes between the sun and the Earth, casting the moon's shadow on the Earth.

Solar Eclipses are so cool because the vast majority of the time, the moon passes either above or below the sun from the Earth's perspective and not directly in front of it.









### National Babe Ruth Day APRIL 27TH

February 6, 1895- August 16th, 1948

George Herman Ruth Jr. "Babe Ruth" remains one of the greatest figures in American baseball history. Born in 1895 in Baltimore, Maryland, Babe Ruth impacted the game of baseball like never before and gave hope to millions of people during the great depression.

His most prominent records were most homeruns in a single season (60) in 1927 which stood until 1961 and the most career home runs (714) which lasted until 1974. Throughout his career, Babe Ruth played for the Atlanta Braves, New York Yankees and the Boston Red Sox

Our Extended Care Facility celebrated Babe Ruth on Saturday, April 27th with members of the Bonners Ferry High School softball team.


