Access to women's healthcare can be difficult in rural communities, especially when patients must travel long distances for routine, preventive, or ongoing care.

Boundary Community Clinics is working to strengthen access locally by adding Madeline Brown, MD, a family medicine physician who provides comprehensive care for adults, children, and families at every stage of life.

Dr. Brown offers full-spectrum family medicine with a strong emphasis on women's health, including routine preventive exams, Pap smears, birth control counseling, hormone replacement therapy, endometrial biopsies, and care for women before, during, and after menopause.

For women in Boundary County, adding these services means more opportunities to receive important healthcare without leaving the community.

"Women deserve access to consistent, comprehensive healthcare throughout every stage of life," said Cassy Lonewolf, Clinic Director. "In a rural community, that means doing everything we can to bring needed services closer to home. Dr. Brown's addition to our team allows Boundary Community Clinics to expand that care while continuing to serve the healthcare needs of entire families."

In addition to women's healthcare, Dr. Brown provides pediatric care, preventive medicine, chronic condition management, and office-based procedures such as skin biopsies and joint injections.

For Dr. Brown, practicing medicine in a small community has long been part of the plan. She has always wanted to become a small-town family physician, where she can get to know her patients, care for multiple generations of families, and build relationships that go beyond a single appointment.
